3. Study Strategies  
Students should...
  - pre-read the chapter before the material is covered in class to familiarize them with terms and concepts.
  - pay attention in class and take notes when necessary.
  - review notes nightly and come to class prepared to ask questions on material that they did not understand.
  - complete homework assignments on time.
  - start studying several days before a test.
  - form study groups (during study halls and at home).
  - reread the chapter as part of their review for a test.
  - review notes, section review questions, chapter review questions, and quizzes as part of their review for a test.
4. Extra Help
  - I am available after school by appointment if any student would like extra help. Students should not hesitate to talk to me about any problems or concerns that they have with the material or the assignments. Students should check with me if they are planning on coming for extra help to ensure that I will be available (there are some days that I have meetings, etc.).
